URGENT TELEGRAM

To the Command of the PrK /Priština Corps//IKM /Forward Command Post/ PrK

REGULAR COMBAT REPORT

1. Activities and changes in the OS /Armed Forces/ of foreign countries of importance for the security of the FRY /Federal Republic of Yugoslavia/. Air raid alerts were broadcast several times during the day and there were air operations in the zone of responsibility. The ŠTS /Šiptar /Albanian/ Terrorist Forces/ conducted operations against the following units of the Brigade in the area: BG /Combat Group/-1, 2, 4, 5 and 6, and BG-252. NATO forces did not conduct operations in our zone of responsibility.

2. Our Forces

Activities of the units:

2.1. BG-1 Acting on the decision of the PrK Commander, took the sector: the villages of Gornje and Donje Barane, Turjak village and is engaged destroying the ŠTS in Jablanica sector per decision of the PrK Commander.

2.- BG-2 Engaged on providing security behind the DG /state border/ and in the territory.

2.3. BG-3 Engaged on providing security behind the DG and in the territory.

2.4. BG-4 It is in the blockade in the sector of Stari Trg and is carrying out tasks per decision of the PrK Commander.

2.5. BG-5 It is engaged per decision of the PrK Commander, in the sector of Kraljane village, Šaban Mahala village and Calat Mahala village, destroying the ŠTS in the Jablanica sector.

2.6. BG-6 Took the position on the axis Gramocelj village - Kodralije village, engaged per decision of the PrK Commander.

A team for mobilising the 3rd mtb /Motorised Battalion/ went to Kraljevo to mobilise it. The team consists of: six officers, one non-commissioned officer, three civilians employed in the army and 10 soldiers.

At 0530 hours on 4 April 1999 in Glodane village, Dečane SO /Municipality/, Private Miloš KORUGA, son of Ilija, of VP /Military Post/ 8365/18 Peć, in the VJ /Yugoslav Army/ since 19 December 1998, at VP 8365/18 Peć since 10 March 1999, born 17

March 1979 in Zemun, residing at /? Branka Pešića/ no. 6 Zemun, JMBG /personal identification number/ 1703979710105, committed suicide.

Decision:

BG-1- Continue carrying out b/d /combat operations/ on the axis: Rašić village-Nove Papračane village, and with part of the forces on the Vranovac-Dašinovac village axis.

BG-5- From the line reached continue operations along the axis: Keli Mahala-Zabelj.

BG-6- Continue the canal-Ratiš village operation.

BG-4- Continue mopping up the terrain around Stari Trg.
